## Writing Certificate: Combined Project Agreement

Students are allowed to combine their Writing Capstone project with an honors thesis or other senior project as long as combining is allowed by the home department, both mentors agree, and the proposed combination is approved by the Associate Director of the Writing Certificate Program.

Students doing a combined project may enroll in WRIT:4000 for 1 s.h. *only*. They will work with their primary mentor on the content of their project, while their writing mentor will provide feedback on language, style, structure, etc. Students must meet all deadlines outlined in the Capstone Mentor Agreement Sheet to receive credit for WRIT:4000.
